Rebranding Note:

You may still see on some scouting websites it still be called "Mallee Rover Camp", and we just wanted to declare it is the same fun loving, jam packed adventurous camp we all know and love.

Right now into the real information:

- Care monkey forms will need to be printed out and brought with you to the camp.
- Venturers are more than welcome to attend. Venturers that attend; cost to Venturers is the same as Leaders and Adult Helpers.
- Ventures and Rovers from away can either help with activities or join your troops. Just let us know what they will be doing so we can accomidate to them. Secretly I think we have more fun then the kids!
- The camp will be centrally catered. Cold storage will be on-site, and ice will be available. Each troop will need to supply the following items:
 - Garbage bags for rubbish!
 - Sleeping Tents
 - Troop First Aid Kits
 - Life Jackets / Buoyancy Vests (limited supply available)

Swimming is not permitted without a life jacket. Leaders/Helpers must be present at all times while your scouts are in the water. Swimming only permitted in designated area.

- Please make sure your Scouts have suitable, enclosed footwear and old clothes for all activities wet and dry.
- Thongs, singlet tops and aerosols are banned for safety reasons.
- The activities will run both morning and afternoon on Saturday and Sunday morning.
- Please note that Fire Restrictions are in force at the time of the camp. <u>Fires are not permitted in Scout camps.</u> They are not needed as there is no troop cooking.
- The camp concludes with flag-down at 1:30pm on Sunday.

Tapio Camp Location Details!



- If you're coming from Victoria or NSW head towards Wentworth via Dareton. To make the trip shorter, as you come into Dareton, on your right there is a road called "Fletchers Lake Road". Follow this road, it twists and turns, but don't turn off onto any small road. This road will continue for some time, going over a number of grids. Eventually after about 20-25 km you will come to a T-intersection. Turn Left here (back towards Wentworth). About 1 km on your right you will find the road into the camp, follow the signs.
- If you are coming from SA, approx 25 km before you get to Mildura, you can take the "Meridian Road", this will bring you to a T-intersection, turn left towards Wentworth and cross over the Abbotsford Bridge. Continue to Wentworth, crossing over the next bridge (Tuckers creek). Go straight ahead at the intersection; do not cross the next bridge (Darling River) to the left. Follow the road for about 25 km and you will pass some sand hills on your right, a river on your left, and you will find a road off to the left. Signs will mark the way into camp.
